

# Renfrewshire Affordable Credit Event



## **DESCRIPTION**

**Why:** Renfrewshire's Affordable Credit Group would like to invite you to an event to promote affordable credit provision in Renfrewshire. The Affordable Credit Group was established last year to improve the financial well-being of Renfrewshire citizens by raising awareness of, and increasing access to, affordable credit.

**What:** This event will be opened by Douglas White of the Carnegie Trust and will consist of stalls promoting affordable credit as well as spotlight workshops/speakers including: Bank Account Myth Busting; Understanding Credit Unions; Explaining Rental Exchange and Scotcash Services. Stalls will be set up so you can have a chat with the experts and ask any questions you have. These will include credit unions from around Renfrewshire, The Bank of Scotland, Lloyds TSB and Scotcash. There will also be a chance to network with a variety of organisations.

Although the event officially opens at 9.30am, you do not need to attend for the full event, all workshops will be repeated twice throughout the morning. A breakfast buffet will be available throughout the event.

**Who:** This event is aimed at practitioners – those who speak to people directly, rather than managers. It will benefit organisations that provide financial advice to the community, either directly or indirectly. This will include Housing Associations, Advice Providers, Community Organisations and Charities.
