



ADVANCED CREATIVE PATHWAYS (10 POSTS), RENFREWSHIRE

We are looking for ten young people aged 16-19 who are currently unemployed to join our creative team for a paid six month traineeship via our Advanced Creative Pathways programme.

Funded through Renfrewshire Council's – Provision of Community Based Transitional Employment Training, this unique opportunity will train 10 young people in a range of Digital Art skills including Digital Photography, 3D Printing and Animation.

The programme will include:

- Weekly training in a range of creative subjects including Digital Photography, 3D Printing, Digital Animation.
- Community Placements will include intergenerational projects with local children and older people.
- Training in Fist Aid, Autism Awareness, children protection, mental health awareness, Dementia Awareness and other relevant training.
- SQA-accredited Employability Award or Steps to Work
- Gain a Bronze Art Award with the opportunity to progress to a Silver Arts Award
- 1-2-1 careers advice and employability support from our Employability Opportunities Team

Salary: Glasgow Living Wage £8.45 per hour for 30 hours per week, rising to £8.75 per hour from 1st April 2018 (this equates to £253.50 per week until 31st March 2018 and £262.50 per week after 1st April 2018).
