### **Background**

The Archaeology Funding Programme operates under section 45 of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 and Section 11 of Historic Environment Scotland Act 2014.

### **Objectives of Fund**

The Archaeology Programme funds research and intervention projects to:

- Further knowledge of the historic environment.
- Rescue archaeological information in the face of unavoidable threats.

### **Value Notes**

There is no minimum or maximum amount. Previous grants have ranged from £50 to £500,000.

Projects may be short and self-contained or, where appropriate, may last several years.

### **Match Funding Restrictions**

In general applicants are expected to fund a significant proportion of a project, or get part-funding from other sources.

### **Who Can Apply**

Those active in archaeology such as universities or heritage trusts.
