## **Background**

The Morrisons Foundation, a registered charity (1160224), has been set up by the supermarket chain Morrisons to support local good causes in England, Scotland and Wales.

The Foundation, a charity registered in England, Wales and Scotland, receives its funding from a number of different sources including the proceeds of the sales of carrier bags from its stores in Scotland and Wales. This income stream is ring-fenced, so money raised from the sale of bags in Scotland/Wales will be spent on charities benefiting people in Scotland/Wales.

## **Objectives of Fund**

The Foundation is offering grants to help get new projects off the ground that will benefit the local community.

The funding is for specific projects which make a difference to people's lives, with special consideration for vulnerable and disadvantaged groups.

## **Value Notes**

There is no minimum or maximum grant level. Funding is at the discretion of the Foundation.

Previous grants have ranged from £750 to £20,000.

## **Who Can Apply**

UK charities (registered with the Charity Commission or Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator) that exist to improve the lives of people and communities in England, Scotland or Wales can apply. Both local and national charities are eligible.
