

Erskine Bridge Pipeline Replacement Project - Update

As part of our ongoing work we will shortly be commissioning the new Erskine Bridge replacement pipeline and decommissioning the old pipeline.

This operation will start on 22 July, with gas due to be vented safely into the atmosphere on 26 and 29 July. The operation is due to finish on 1 August.

Commissioning will take place on 26 July and will involve the release of gas during the day.

Decommissioning will take place on 29 July after 7pm and will last approximately two and a half hours. Decommissioning will be noisy and it will be highly likely you will smell gas during this time. If you do have any safety concerns, or smell gas that you think may not be related to this operation, please call the National Gas Emergency Number on 0800 111 999.
