



Scotland's Community Capacity and Resilience Fund

Opens for Round 4

The Scottish Government provides the money for this fund which is administered by the Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations (SCVO).

Grants are available to give local community based organisations who are tackling the effects of welfare reform the opportunity to test out new, creative approaches, develop their workforce and add capacity all with the aim of having a preventative impact on communities, help combat social inequalities, promote social inclusion and support partnership working.

Round 4 is seeking to support a broad range of projects and activities that support local community based organisations across Scotland to help people mitigate the effects of welfare reform by providing them with the support and skills they need.

Round 4 will provide grants of:

- Between £1,000 and £5,000 for projects of up to 9 months, starting 1 December and completed by 30 September 2019.
- Up to £10,000 for pilot/test projects of 12 months, starting 1 December and completed by 31 December 2019.

Third sector organisations based in Scotland and delivering services in Scotland, with an annual income of £250,000 or less, can apply.
