In July of 2019, Scotland will have the privilege of hosting the 18<sup>th</sup> edition of the UEFA Women's Under-19 Championship. All interested volunteers are invited to apply to join the team. You do not need to have experience of driving delegates, but all roles require a friendly and respectful approach. You must be willing to learn from others and work as a member of the team with the shared focus of delivering the best possible experience to all fans and stakeholders in the UEFA Women's Under-19's Championship.
