Renfrewshire Council, working alongside four local housing associations, has developed a draft Common Housing Allocation Policy for Renfrewshire. This will provide a joint approach to allocating Council and Housing Association homes throughout Renfrewshire.

Together we are committed to providing high quality, affordable housing that meets peoples' housing needs. The new proposed draft Common Housing Allocation Policy has been prepared to reflect the changes being introduced by the Housing (Scotland) Act 2014.

Your views on how we apply the new legislation and deliver our commitment to meet people's housing needs within the policy are very important to us. We are therefore holding a two-part consultation process on our proposed draft Common Housing Allocation Policy.
