Universal Credit rolls out in Renfrewshire on September 19th, 2018. Engage Renfrewshire is committed to empowering our member organisations to be informed and prepared for the rollout, because this in turn means our local third sector can effectively support new claimants and others who will be affected.

We know from other areas of the UK who have already implemented universal credit that the impact can be significant because claimants are paid 4 weeks in arrears. This means that some individuals and families will be without income for a minimum of 5 weeks while a claim is processed and then paid.
