Background

The Asda Foundation is a charitable corporate Foundation which provides grants throughout the UK to improve the lives of people and communities.

Objectives of Fund

The funding is intended to support a range of good causes that have the direct support and involvement from their local ASDA store.

Previous Success

Examples of previously successful groups include:

- Carers Resource in Shipley, which provides support and information to unpaid carers and those in need of care and support, received funding to help with decorating, replacing worn out carpets and replacing 30 old chairs.
- Helping Hands in Scotland runs three groups which provide support for people living with dementia, their carers and vulnerable older people in the community. The funding will purchase a van for the group so they can take their members out on more outings.
- The Canolfan Pentre, in Wales, is a community social and learning hub run by community members. The funding will replace the old boiler that no longer works.
- The Princes Trust on the East Coast of Scotland, works with disadvantaged young people to build confidence, increase motivation and improve their employability skills. The funding is for 61 development awards and associated costs in communities surrounding 61 Asda stores.
