Background

This scheme is one of four new funding programmes announced by the Bank of Scotland Foundation for 2019 and 2020, as part of their five year 'Supporting Positive Change Across Scotland' plan.

The scheme is administered by the Foundation with funding provided by Lloyds Banking Group.

Objectives of Fund

The funding is intended for registered charities in Scotland who are creating positive and lasting changes for Scotland's people and communities by supporting people through varying stages of their lives, and addressing social exclusion and disadvantage.

Value Notes

Grants of £1,000 to £20,000 over one year are available.

Who Can Apply

Charities registered in Scotland, operational for more than one year, are eligible to apply.

Applicants must:

- Have an annual income of £1 million or less.
- Have all regulatory returns up to date as OSCR and Companies House.
- Be able to provide annual accounts which have been:
 - Checked by OSCR and Companies House.
 - Signed by an independent examiner and a member of the board.
