

Scottish Government - Fireworks public consultation event

Scottish Government are currently consulting on the use and regulation of fireworks in Scotland. As part of this process, they are looking for views from the public at a series of meetings across Scotland.

This is one of a series of engagement events on the Scottish Government's Consultation on Fireworks, where individuals, communities and professionals are invited to come along to give their views.
