Our projects have made a huge impact on many people's lives and we're looking for a Development Officer to join the team to work on our latest initiative "In Business for Good".

This person will be responsible for increasing our trading income opportunities with a priority on extending our work on the out of school holiday provision – increasing beneficiary reach/numbers and delivery sites to boost our trading income and our impact. We will, as a result, enhance the scale and scope of 'out of school holiday' provision – introduce subsidised places for children from low income families; introduce a food offering, provide free transport and branded kit and equipment, thus improving accessibility for families across Glasgow.

The Development Officer will also identify new areas of business for income generation, which will, in turn reduce our reliance on grant funding and support a more enterprising business model delivering social good. We have already built good relationships with local Housing Associations and other community groups, – but we could with increased capacity and focus, be doing a lot more as a community anchor organisation.

We're looking for:

- Clear and concise written and spoken communication skills
- Ability to present written information in a structured and balanced way
- Ability to identify opportunities for income generation
- Able to create content for social media platforms for effective marketing and sales.
- Ability to manage and work within budget guidelines

Ideally, you'll have:

- Experience of preparing reports and presentations for a variety of audiences
- Some knowledge of social enterprise sector and it's principles
- Good working knowledge of social media
- A full driving licence

- Be a good team worker, demonstrating loyalty and commitment to the organization and team members
- Dynamic and able to mix in a variety of settings
