

GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) IMPACT Awards 2018 - Imminent Deadline

The GSK IMPACT Awards are an annual scheme, funded by GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) as part of the company's commitment to promoting community health and wellbeing. The Awards are organised and managed in partnership with the King's Fund, a leading independent health charity working to improve health and social care.

The awards reward UK registered charities that are doing excellent work to improve people's health. Organisations must be at least three years old, working in a health-related field in the UK, with an income of between £80,000 and £2.5 million. Up to 20 awards will be made ranging from £3,000 to £40,000 plus free training valued at up to £6,000. The winning organisations will also have a film made, receive help with press and publicity and be given a set of promotional materials.

Applicants may also find it useful to read a report recently published by The King's Fund that shares 10 tips for charity leaders. The report is based on the knowledge and feedback gained from 20 years of working on the GSK IMPACT Awards.
