



### **Isolation Fund - HSCP and Impact Funding partners**

We've been made aware of a small fund which has been opened to voluntary and community organisations to help tackle social isolation over the Christmas period.

Impact Funding Partners is inviting applications from third sector organisations and community groups to this fund. The fund will open for applications on 25th November and will close on 16th December 2019.

Impact Funding Partners is managing this fund on behalf of Glasgow Health and Social Care Partnership (GHSCP).

GHSCP has made available £56,000 to local organisations providing services to Glasgow City residents, to enable them to support individuals who may be isolated over the festive period.

Priority will be given to organisations working with individuals most at risk of social isolation and loneliness. For example, older people, carers, minority ethnic people, disabled people, homeless people, lone parents, adults with additional support needs and people with long term health conditions.

Organisations do not need to be a registered charity, but organisational constitutions/rules should make clear that funds will only be spent on purposes established in the constitution, and not distributed amongst members. • You must be currently delivering a service to, or have previously worked with the intended beneficiary group(s) of this application. •
