

## **Early Action System Change in Renfrewshire**

Renfrewshire Council, Renfrewshire Health and Social Care Partnership and Engage Renfrewshire are working in partnership to undertake a three-year System Change initiative to promote young people's emotional wellbeing and to address emotional coercive control in adolescent relationships. This work forms part of The National Lottery Community Fund's Early Action System Change Fund which aims to address the root causes of inequality.

Early Action System Change in Renfrewshire are holding a Learning Event on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July from 2pm to 4pm** at the Watermill Hotel, Bladda Lane, Paisley PA1 1SR. 12 voluntary sector organisations have been awarded grants totalling £30,000 to work with children, young people and families to gain a better understanding of the priority challenges and drivers, and they will deliver short inputs about the insights/lessons learned from their work.
